

Dear Friend,

Thank you for your interest in my 10 Month Herbal Studies Program. Our first class weekend is February 20 and 21, 2010. Class will be held at Dandelion Herbal Center, our home, 4803 Greenwood Heights Drive, Kneeland from 10 am to 4 pm. Please arrive by 9:45.

Through your participation in the Herbal Studies Program you will gain an in-depth understanding and working knowledge of the way of herbs. We'll cover such topics as herbal therapeutics, materia medica, wild plant identification, flower essences, wild foods and herb gardening. We'll spend time in the classroom with lecture and discussion and time in the field identifying and getting to know local edible and medicinal plants. We'll gather plants and prepare our herbal pharmacy. We'll explore the herb business through a weekend field trip to Southern Oregon to visit Pacific Botanicals and HerbPharm. We'll celebrate the Solstice and Equinoxes and every day with song and ceremony.

Please find enclosed a student application form and syllabus of our program. Our schedule will naturally evolve as we do, so be prepared for some changes in content. The prerequisite for this program is a basic understanding of herbalism, covered in our Beginning with Herbs class which is next offered January 13 – March 10, 2010. If you have learned this material in another class or on your own, please talk to me.

The tuition is \$1740.00 which covers all instruction, in-class materials, Rosemary Gladstar's ten lesson home study course (\$375.00 value), correction of all homework, a certificate of completion from Dandelion Herbal Center and The Science and Art of Herbalism and membership to United Plant Savers. To reserve your space, \$500.00 is due at this time along with your completed application. Remaining tuition is due Dec.30. Tuition, minus a \$150.00 processing fee is refundable up to February 1, after that time you may apply the tuition to next years class.
